

## Competency/Certification Exams

CTTAM has launched a new certification model that incorporates competency exams to evaluate competency at the Technologist level and enables Certified Technicians (C.Tech.) to become certified as a Certified Technologist (C.E.T.). All graduates of non-accredited\* technology programs, including international engineering graduates from non-accredited programs, will be required to write the competency exam if their academics have been assessed at the Technologist level and they wish to become a Certified Technologist. CTTAM Members **must** already be certified at the Technician level in order to write the competency exam.

Passing the exam alone does not ensure promotion to a C.E.T. and the Member must also complete a competency summary, signed by either a C.E.T. or a P.Eng., to validate their work experience and knowledge at a Technologist level.

There are currently six (6) competency exams available:

Civil  
Electrical  
Electronics  
Fundamentals of Technology  
Mechanical  
Petroleum

The cost of the exam is \$252 including G.S.T.

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*\***Non-accredited** programs are those programs that are not TAC or CTAB accredited in Canada or are not recognized internationally by the International Engineering Alliance (IEA) (Washington, Sydney and Dublin Accords).*
